

Court Ordered Community Service Opportunity

Hospitality House of Charlotte offers a specialized opportunity for individuals in need of court ordered community service hours.

Our Linen program offers a 90-minute opportunity where volunteers assist in organizing and folding clean linens. These linens are essential for our housekeeping staff to promptly prepare beds. Volunteers are required to remain on their feet throughout the shift and handle large bags of linens. Upon arrival, volunteers sign in using our computer system. Our Community Engagement Coordinator will provide necessary verification when needed.

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age.
- Must provide a copy of the court document or ticket stating your offense.
- Must provide a photo ID.
- You must dress appropriately. Shorts of a respectful length are permitted. No midriff or crop tops. No undergarments are to be shown.
- Must be able to bend, stand during the entire shift, and lift up to 15 pounds.

Please Note:

- If you do not show up to your scheduled shift without letting us know, all upcoming scheduled dates will be canceled and you will not be able to complete your hours at Hospitality House of Charlotte.
- Do not attend if you have a fever or do not feel well.
- No weapons of any kind are permitted on our premises.
- This is the only shift available for Court Ordered or Lawyer Recommended service hours. Please do not sign up for anything other than our Linen opportunity.
