Meals that Heal

Help provide a delicious meal for HHOC guests through the Meals that Heal program. Volunteers can sign up to cook onsite or drop off 25-30 individually packaged meal portions for guests. Volunteers are responsible for choosing a meal and providing all the ingredients needed. This activity is great for smaller groups of between three and ten volunteers.





Clean Linen Crew

The Clean Linen Crew ensures that each bed is freshly made for guests upon arrival. This activity consists of folding and organizing clean linens for HHOC's housekeeping staff, perfect for individuals or a small group of two to five volunteers.





Landscaping Helpers

In the spring, summer, and fall seasons, the Landscaping Helpers opportunity is perfect for those looking to get outside. This activity consists of pulling weeds, trimming hedges, and overall keeping the House's yard looking fresh. This activity is great for groups of all size ranging from smaller groups of five up to large groups of 20 volunteers.
